PROJECT BOOK BOX

Project book boxes encourage children to work independently and deepen their understanding of subjects.

RESOURCE BOX

Resource boxes include items that enable children to explore themes and ideas in books through physical objects

SUPPORTING ADDITIONAL NEEDS

All children should be able to enjoy reading for pleasure

- We supply Barrington Stoke published books which are developed to support young people with dyslexia.
- We have sensory books, braille texts and large print books that can be used by young people with Visual Impairment. Some children with autism also engage with sensory books.
- We are able to provide books in other languages for young people with English as an Additional Language.
- We are always looking for ways to develop our offer-so if you have a young person or group with an additional need, please let us know.



CHATTERBOOKS

Chatterbooks is the UK's largest network of children's reading groups.

Boxes of books around themes such as Coding, Shakespeare and Witches and Wizards are delivered to schools and used to generate discussion and encourage children to enjoy reading.

The groups are run by librarians, teachers, teaching assistants, or volunteers - anyone with a passion for reading.

Chatterbooks is a flexible model that can be used with children from 4 up to 12, for all different abilities and in targeted or mixed groups.

Hull SLS will provide training and support to school staff to run sessions.

JAMES RECKITT HULL CHILDREN'S BOOK AWARDS



The awards are supported by author visits in the months prior to the voting ceremonies.

Schools come together in the Summer term to vote on the winning author.

Pupils can also achieve their Arts Award Discover by logging their ideas in a James Reckitt Diary.

AUTUMN/SUMMER MEET UPS


Have you found yourself in charge of the library and want advice?
